## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

**PLEASE NOTE:** The PowerRoll™ Cigarette Machine makes KING SIZE cigarettes only.

1. Plug in machine and turn the power switch on. (Fig. A)

3. Open Chamber Guard (Fig. C)

2. Slide the open end of a cigarette tube onto nozzle. (Fig. B)

4. Filling the corners first, deposit tobacco evenly in the Tobacco Chamber. DO NOT OVERFILL! (Fig. D)

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (CONT.)

5. Use Tamper to pack tobacco down evenly. (Fig. E)

6. Clear top of machine of loose tobacco then close Chamber Guard (Fig. F)

7. Press AND release Chamber Guard over start button (as indicated) to activate injector. (Fig. G)

Turn off unit when not in use.

## CAUTION

In the event of a jam, the machine will reset itself to the starting position and the Jam Indicator Light will flash. (Fig. H)

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (CONT.)

### Clearing a Jam

1. After removing tube from nozzle, open Chamber Guard, then turn the Power Switch off. (Fig. I)

3. Turn the Power Switch on and close the Chamber Guard. (Fig. K)

2. Use the supplied Clearing Rod and Nozzle Brush to remove all tobacco from Tobacco Chamber (Fig. J)

4. Keeping fingers and hands AWAY FROM NOZZLE OPENING, press and release the Chamber Guard to activate injector and ensure successful removal of jam. (Fig. L)

The machine is now ready for use.

## READ BEFORE OPERATING YOUR POWERROLL™ CIGARETTE MACHINE

### MAINTENANCE, CARE & HANDLING

- Keep cigarette machine out of the reach of children.
  - Clean tobacco chamber and nozzle after every use.
  - Clean your machine regularly by removing tobacco residue from tobacco chamber with the supplied Clearing Rod and Nozzle Brush.
  - Do not immerse machine in water.
  - To prevent jamming of the device, avoid the following types of tobacco:
    - Overly moist tobacco (such as pipe tobacco)
    - Overly dry tobacco
    - Very fine cut tobacco
- Do not take machine apart!**  
Doing so will void the warranty.
- The use of other adaptors will void the warranty.**
- Do not overfill the tobacco chamber!**  
Doing so will cause the machine to jam. Forcing the machine to inject jammed tobacco will void the warranty.
- Always keep hands/fingers away from nozzle opening & tobacco chamber when pressing the 'start' button to avoid cuts & lacerations. Extended injector is very sharp!** (Fig. 1)
